

## ART EXHIBITIONS

The Waterways Museum offers a variety of unusual and memorable settings for Art Exhibitions.

Although it is free to exhibit, any sales, which are produced through your exhibition, will be subject to a 25% commission.

The first and primary exhibition space we have to offer is Floating Art Gallery Room 58.

Our second exhibition space is located in the Museum foyer. This offers a large amount of wall space, with various lighting options. (Natural light, overhead lights and directional spotlights.)

Both spaces are open to the public during Museum opening hours offering good exhibition exposure.

A variety of packages are available, from evening viewings to production of advertisement material. We can arrange this to suit your needs.

- Artwork must be removed before the next exhibition has commenced. If you are unable to do this you must inform us allowing at least a week, so that alternative arrangements can be made.
- The Waterways Museum will act as a vendor for your artwork. For this to be successful we will require a price list, which must be supplied before the exhibition commences. The waterways Museum charges a 25% fee on art sold during the exhibition period.
- You are responsible for all transportation of your art.
- If you require an evening launch this must be booked at least one month before the commencement of your exhibition so arrangements can be made.
