

FLOATING ART GALLERY AVAILABLE FOR CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS.

Room 58 is a former grain barge, berthed at the Museum, which has been converted into an events and conference facility. The vessel can accommodate up to 70 people but is also comfortable for much smaller numbers. The floating venue is licensed to hold wedding ceremonies and offers a very unique location for special events.

It is very popular as a corporate training room or meeting area with a ‘get away from it all’ feeling derived from its tranquil canal side setting. Room 58 is moored alongside the Waterways Museum in Goole where there is also further meeting space available and is serviced with an excellent catering facility available on request. There is a small kitchen and toilets on board but our Café and catering service can supply menus to meet a range of budgets.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

History Tours around Goole Docks can be arranged for delegates aboard our converted lifeboat, also moored at the Waterways Museum

Other facilities associated with meetings can also be supplied by arrangement and include an OHP, flipcharts, and a PowerPoint projector.
